Reply : The information has already been provided vide our letter of even No. dated 04.04.2013. However, a copy of notification issued by Planning Commission No. A-43011/02/2009-Admn.I dated 28th January, 2009 is enclosed.

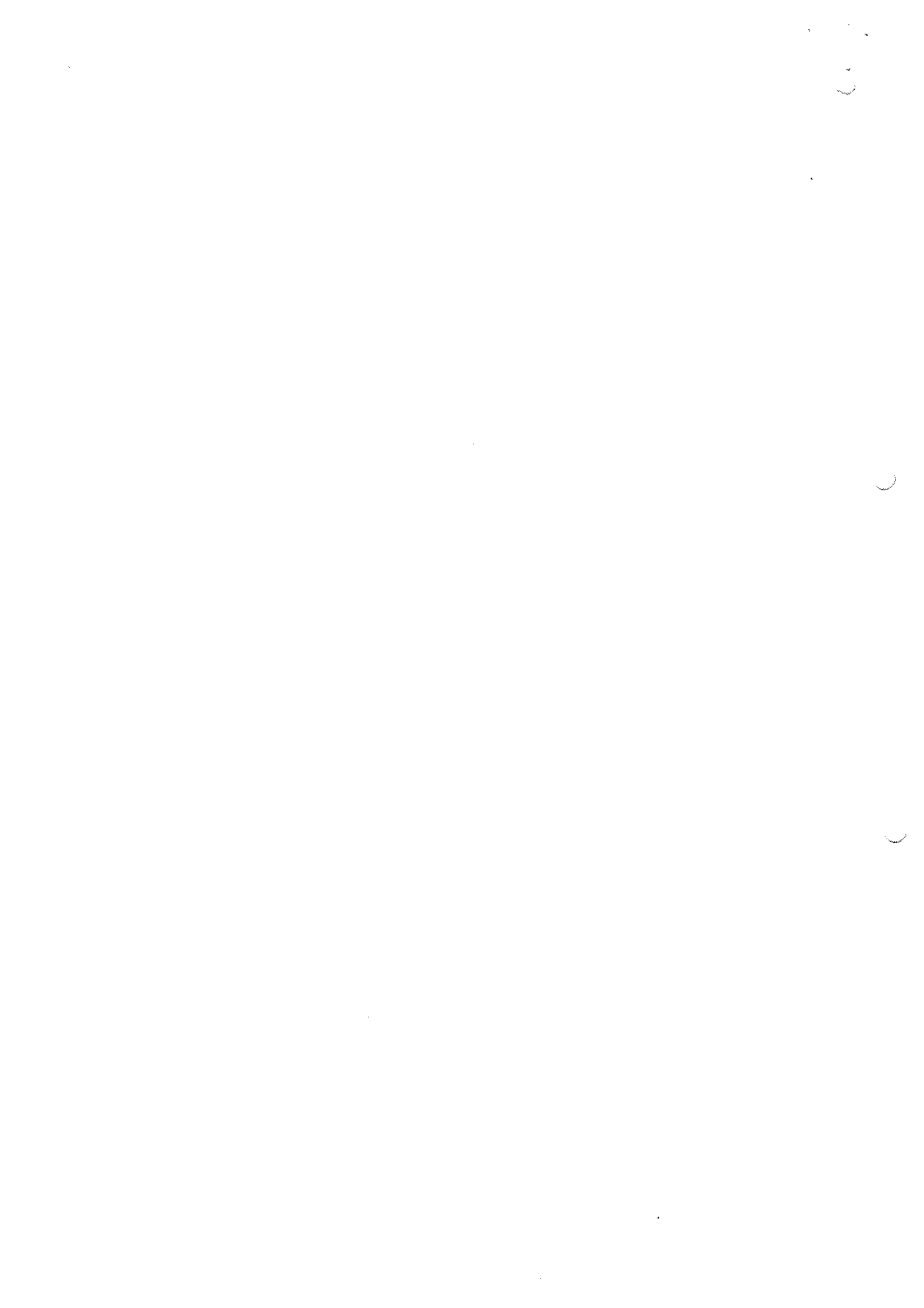
Q.3 : List of partners, state ministries, departments, Dept. of Expenditure under the Ministry of Finance has sent above noted Notification and Government resolutions to act as Registrars for implementation of the scheme in India and especially in Maharashtra.

Reply : The enrolment of residents under the Aadhaar Project is undertaken in partnership with Registrars, who are State and Central Government Ministries/Departments/Public Sector Banks, etc. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed with each of the State and Central Registrars & with scheduled commercial banks and other financial institutions like LIC, NSDL, etc. As per the MoU containing guidelines for collection of data, UIDAI shall, among other things, develop and prescribe standards for recording data fields, data verification and biometric field, prescribe a process for enrolment of residents, while the Registrars shall identify and appoint enrolment agencies, who in turn must follow the standards and processes prescribed by UIDAI at the time of recording the residents' data.

Information pertaining to UIDAI Registrars has already been provided vide our letter of even No. dated 04th June, 2013. However, it is once again stated that the information is readily available on UIDAI website www.uidai.gov.in under Registrar – Registrar & Enrolment tab.
