2. It is informed that, on the basis of the decisions taken in the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Implementation Committee on Electronic Transfer of Benefits in the Ministry of Labour & Employment, this Ministry had requested Planning Commission (copy enclosed) for excluding the following two schemes pertaining to ESIC and EPFO, respectively, from the list of schemes of this Ministry identified for implementation of Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT):

- i) Permanent Disability Benefits, Dependent Benefits, Sickness / Benefits, Maternity Benefits, Funeral Expenses by the Employees State Insurance Corporation to the insured persons and their families (Implemented directly by ESIC).
- ii) Pension, Withdrawal of Provident Fund, Premature Withdrawal of Pension, Payment related to Employees Deposit Linked Insurance by the Employees Provident Fund Organization (Implemented directly by EPFO).

*Dear Mr. K. Chatterjee,*

You may please recall that the following schemes of Ministry of Labour & Employment are presently listed among the 34 identified schemes which are amenable to Direct Cash Transfers:

- I. Scholarship / Stipend to the children of beedi workers.
- II. Housing subsidy to beedi workers.
- III. Stipend to children in the special schools under the National Child Labour Project.
- IV. Permanent Disability Benefits, Dependent Benefits, Sickness/Benefits, Maternity Benefits, Funeral Expenses by the Employees State Insurance Corporation to the insured persons and their families (Implemented directly by ESIC).
- V. Pension, Withdrawal of Provident Fund, Premature Withdrawal of Pension, Payment related to Employees Deposit Linked Insurance by the Employees Provident Fund Organization. (Implemented directly by EPFO).

2. Since the schemes at sl. no. (iv) and (v) above are neither Central Sector nor Centrally Sponsored Schemes and are implemented directly by this Ministry's Autonomous Bodies viz ESIC and EPFO, respectively, it has been decided to exclude these two schemes from the list of identified schemes of this Ministry for implementation of Direct Cash Transfers on 01-01-2013.

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3. The Ministry now proposes to replace the above two schemes with the following two schemes which are also found amenable to Direct Cash Transfers:

- I. Stipend to trainees under the Scheme of Welfare of SC/ST job seekers through Coaching, Guidance and Vocational Training.
- II. Payment of stipend to trainees under the Scheme of Skill Development in 34 Districts affected by Left Wing Extremism(LWE).

4. Accordingly, the **final list** of the schemes of the Ministry of Labour & Employment identified for implementation of Direct Cash Transfers on 01-01-2013 is as follows:

- I. Scholarship / Stipend to the children of beedi workers.
- II. Housing subsidy to beedi workers.
- III Stipend to children in the special schools under the National Child Labour Project.
- IV. Stipend to trainees under the Scheme of Welfare of SC/ST job seekers through Coaching, Guidance and Vocational Training.
- V. Payment of stipend to trainees under the Scheme of Skill Development in 34 Districts affected by Left Wing Extremism(LWE).

5. It is requested that the above revision may be made in respect of schemes of Ministry of Labour & Employment in the list of 34 schemes identified for roll out of Direct Cash Transfers on 01.01.2013.
