Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your above mentioned letter by which you have transferred my RTI application to the UIDAI for point nos. 1 to 4.

I do suggest that my application be scrutinized carefully as the information be requested pertains to Aadhar UIDAI but with relevance to your Ministry.

In this regards, please refer to the guidelines dated 08.11.2007 issued by your Ministry with regards to RTI Act 2005.

You may transfer my application inter-departmentally if I had addressed it to the wrong CPIO, just like Shri G.H. Muralidhar, Section Officer has veru kindly forwarded it to CPIOs of various divisions / wings within Ministry of Women And Child Development. However, as I definitely know that Aadhar is under the UIDAI, Planning Commission , so there was no need for me to route the RTI through your Ministry.

Point nos. 1 to 4 must be replied by you by 'yes' (in which case you need to give me supporting documents after due payment from me) or 'no' as all 4 questions are with relevance to Aadhar UIDAI but with regards to the documents in your Ministry's files.

I draw your attention to the Dhanalakshmi scheme which is included under DBT. Since you are not informed about Aadhar, it is assumed that your ministry will transfer this without any imposition on the receiver for linking to Aadhar.

I have attached my RTI application dated 12.03.2013 again for your to reply within 30 days of the date. After that, I will be forced to take assistance from the first Appellate Authority.
