Point 6: Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), one of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme is a special area development programme which aims at improving the socio-economic infrastructure and basic amenities for uplifting the quality of life of the minorities. This scheme was launched in 2008-09 in 90 identified minority concentration districts (MCDs) in 20 States/UTs of the country with a total allocation of Rs. 3780 crore for this programme during 11th Five Year Plan and continued in 2012-13. This programme gives funds to creation of infrastructure related to school building, class rooms, hostels, health centres, housing, drinking water, ITIs, polytechnics etc. Other details are available at the website of this Ministry at www.minorityaffairs.gov.in.
