Subject: Clarification regarding UID and NPR enrolment in Maharashtra

Dear Sir,

This is in reference to the enrolment of residents for UID in the State of Maharashtra. As per the guidelines received by the State government from UIDAI, Govt. of India, the State has initiated the process of appointment of agencies for enrolment of resident's data in the State. The State had earlier successfully completed the pilot in Nandurbar and Mumbai, followed by National launch of the project from Nandurbar on 29th September, 2010.

2. However, with reference to the above mentioned letter and the presentation made by DIT, Govt. of India in the Regional workshop conducted in Mumbai on 4th Oct 2010, we understand that Registrar General of India (RGI) shall also be collecting demographic and biometric data for National Population Register (NPR), and the same shall be used by UIDAI for de-duplication and generation of Aadhaar number. In this regard, instead of appointing one of the public sector enterprises like ECIL, BHEL, ITI etc for enrolment of data in the State, RGI may appoint SETU, Maharashtra (a society formed by the State Government for implementation of various ICT and e-Governance initiatives of the State) for the implementation of this project. SETU shall execute the work as per the provisions of the Census Act 1948 and Citizenship Act 1955.

3. We understand that there can be chances of duplication of effort and would request for further clarification with respect to the involvement of various agencies for data enrolment and the roles and responsibilities of each.
