Subject: Regd. UID: Financial Incentives for BPL population on successful generation of Aadhaar number

As you are aware Govt. of Maharashtra is on the verge to kick start the enrolment process across the State. Selected enrolment agencies have been instructed to commence the enrolment process by 10th Jan, 2011.

In accordance to the Tenth Finance commission grant and UIDAI Grant, Rs 100 per person would be provided to residents belonging to BPL (as per the urban development survey) upon successful issue of Aadhaar number. The support to the BPL beneficiaries would be provided through their respective bank accounts of BPL resident. You are required to ensure that the bank accounts of these beneficiaries are opened during the UID enrolment process and would oversee the distribution of the funds later. This financial support would be provided till it is received from Govt. of India and is subject to change in accordance to Govt. of India directives.

You are required to submit the total BPL population in your district to enable us to release funds for the aforesaid financial incentives on every successful generation of Aadhaar number for BPL person.
