Subject: Working on the Non State Registrar in the State of Maharashtra

Reference: Minutes of the Apex Committee Meeting dated 7th July

This is in reference to the decision taken by the State Apex Committee chaired by the Hon. Chief Secretary on 7th July regarding the working of the non State Registrars in the State, wherein the State has decided to allow the non State Registrars to work in the State.

- 2. You are required to follow the given steps in order to work in the state in the most efficient and coordinated manner to ensure maximum enrolment in the shortest possible time:
 - You need to submit the list of enrolment agencies appointed by you and the no. of kits to be deployed by the enrolment agency across the state (the data needs to be segregated based on the districts/municipal corporations) to DIT, GoM
 - DIT, Govt. of Maharashtra shall consolidate the list and send it to the respective districts/municipal corporations
 - The District Collectors/ Municipal Commissioners, in consultation with the enrolment agencies of the State Govt. and your representatives, shall finalize the area which are to be covered by your enrolment agencies for enrolment (apart from the branches/premises of their Registrars) and the same shall be communicated to you
- You are also required to ensure and facilitate the following:



- a. Your enrolment agencies share the KYR and KYR+ data needed by the State Govt. as per the provisions and guidelines of data sharing of UIDAI
- b. The MIS of data collected in Maharashtra is made available to the State Govt.
- c. Follow all procedures strictly in accordance with your MoU with UIDAI
