Subject: Application under RTI Act, 2005 seeking information with regards to issue of duplicate UID number letter to Dr. Montek Singh Ahluwalia after he report it's loss.

Madam,

Please refer to your RTI Application dated 01st June, 2013 received in this Authority on 04.06.13. Information is given as under:

- Q. 1 :** UIDAI SOPs from start to finish, along with protocol and timeline for reporting loss, enrolment and issuance of duplicate UID number letter in lieu of lost UID.
- Q.2 :** List of PoI and PoA documents that are required as supporting to the re-enrolment form for issuance of duplicate UID number.
- Q. 3 :** Name the designations / entities / levels who have permission / access to search encrypted data in the CIDR server in the absence of documentation as per protocol or any deviation.
- Q. 4 :** List the nature of circumstances under which access is permitted and the list of documentation that are required for access.
- Reply 1 to 4 :** Information will be provided shortly.
- Q. 5 :** Copy of the FIR filed by Dr. Montek Singh Ahluwalia for lost UID number and submitted to UIDAI (as is the procedure for obtaining the duplicate of any official identification and / or document as per Indian Law).
- Q. 6 :** Copy of the UID form he completed for issuance of duplicate UID at the time he mentioned the loss of the UID during the UIDAI function.
- Q. 7 :** State the SOPs, protocol & timeline from start to finish followed by UIDAI for issuance of duplicate UID number when Dr. Montek Singh Ahluwalia reported his UID was lost during the UIDAI function.
- Q. 8 :** State what technological tool was used to gain access to encrypted data to locate his correct UID details in the UIDAI database in case he did not complete the re-enrolment form giving his full demographic & biometric data this second time.
- Q.9 :** Name of the entity / designation / level who ordered the issuance of the duplicate UID during the UIDAI function as soon as the loss was mentioned by Dr. Montek Singh Ahluwalia and this copy of the documents that was provided to gain access.

Reply 5 to 9: Shri Montek Singh Ahluwalia, Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission was provided with a copy of e-Aadhaar in respect of his EID. No duplicate Aadhaar Letter was given to Shri Montek Singh Ahluwalia, Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission.


