Thank you for your above mentioned letter, but let me point out at the outset that your reply was dated 28 days after the deadline of 30 days as stated in my letter of 19.04.2013

While I will scrutinize all your points in due course with reference to my representation letter dated 19.04.2013, preliminarily and in continuance I would like to have the following on or by 30 June 2013 :

1. Copy / copies of instances where "innumerable instances of policy being driven by executive action rather than by legislation".
2. State the basis of UIDAI's claim that neither "is it unconstitutional nor illegal" by giving the copy / copies of opinion of the Law Ministry and Attorney General in this regard.
3. Copy of the extract of "the definition of resident in conformity with the definition in 'Population Register' as given in Rule 2(l) of the Citizenship (Registration of Citizens and issue of National Identity Cards) Rules 2003 which have been framed under the Citizenship Act 1955."
4. Copy of the study conducted by the "NIPFM" as this could not be located on the UIDAI website.
