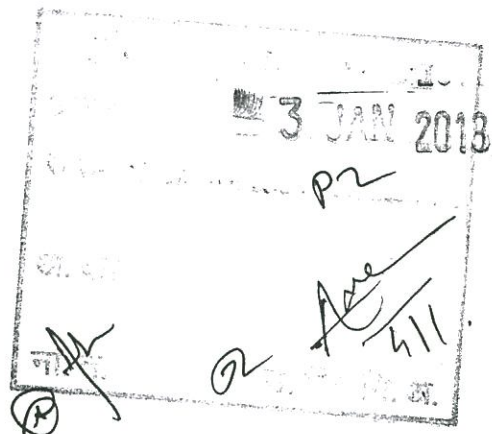

Dear Sir,

With reference to the above, I am directed to inform that the District Collectors must identify the list of beneficiaries under the 34 schemes as applicable in their district and start seeding the Aadhaar numbers immediately by reaching them out to them through special camps near them. Beneficiaries may be called to the camps/offices with details of the Aadhaar number to ensure seeding. Alternatively, the UID enrolment of the beneficiaries should be done on priority in case they haven't yet enrolled for UID.

2. To ensure the above, it is requested that till the time of completion of the UID enrolment of all beneficiaries of the 34 schemes in the district, the District Collectors must have dedicated UID enrolment centers focused for conducting enrolments for them. Additionally, you are requested to ensure that, the enlisted beneficiaries have bank accounts through nationalized banks and their EID or UID is linked to their bank account. The progress of the same shall be made available to DIT and UIDAI on regular basis in the attached format enclosed. The remaining population shall be targeted for enrolments once all the beneficiaries have been enrolled.

3. You are requested to take actions immediate actions as mentioned above and confirm.
