(list available on the website [aadhaar.maharashtra.gov.in](http://aadhaar.maharashtra.gov.in)), any of the Non State Registrars working in Maharashtra or you can appoint your own enrolment agencies (applicable for the districts of Nandurbar, Amravati, Pune) as per the guidelines sent to you earlier
3. Ensure Aadhaar linked bank account opening for all beneficiaries or linking of Aadhaar numbers with the existing bank accounts with the help of the Lead Bank for your district or any other Nationalized Bank with core banking facility
4. Seed the UID number /EID number and the bank account details with the data of the beneficiary

5. Submit daily MIS to uid@maharashtra.gov.in in the enclosed format on the status of the work done (a dedicated nodal officer needs to be appointed for this, as this data gets reported to Govt. of India on a daily basis)
2. You are directed to personally monitor this activity on a time-bound manner and ensure successful completion at the earliest.
