Item 1, 3 & 4: The Election Commission of India has not received or forwarded thereafter any Order, notification, or Government resolution for implementation of UIDAI. Further, at present no Standard Operating Procedure, mechanism or system to implement, integrate, migrate and authenticate any individual's UIDAI card when available with Voter ID card is available in the records of the Commission in any material form.

However, it may be mentioned here that communication between the Election Commission of India and the UIDAI regarding Aadhar number and EPIC synchronization is available in the Commission's file Nos. 23/UID/2011 & 23/UID/2012. You may inspect the above files with 3 days prior intimation to the undersigned and request for specific documents, whichever required thereafter.

Item 2: This item has been transferred under section 6(3) of RTI Act, 2005 to the Public Information Officer, O/o Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) vide Commission's letter of even number dated 14/03/13.
