With reference to the above RTI Query of Ms.Qaneez-e-fatemah Sukhrani the following information is furnished.

Point No.2 State details of the process of de-duplication that has been put in place by NPR in relation to UIDAI.

1. All packets are demographically de-duplicated in QA sub-system using DDC tool.
2. After successful completion of QA activity, they are picked up by SEDA for further processing with BSPs.
3. BSPs de-duplicates the resident's biometrics (iris/fingerprints) with the gallery of existing residents to check uniqueness.
4. If it finds uniqueness, then aadhaar is generated.
5. If it finds matching biometrics; it is send to MDD for further analysis manually.
