Dear Sir,

With reference to above, at the outset I would like to record that the reply was dated 30.07.2013 which is 13 days overdue. Over and above that it was received only on 5th August 2013.

Further, in reply to your points do note that :

1. As in the past, CPIO has forgotten to attach the documents as stated in reply to my Q.2 and Q.6. Kindly send the attachments without further delay.
2. By my address you are aware that I live in Pune, so it is not possible to come personally to UIDAI (HQ) in New Delhi to explain two queries and look for the records. Hence I am explaining it step by step below :
 - (a) **Q.4** → All file notings to commence implementation of the UID project between circulation of the stated notification to the listed entities and introduction of the stated Bill in Rajya Sabha on 03.12.2010
Explanation for Q.4 → Notification No. A-43011/02/2009-Admn.I dated 28.01.2009 was circulated to a list of recipients to announce the constitution of an attached office under Planning Commission → Draft NIAI Bill 2010 was introduced in Rajya Sabha on 03.12.2010 → It was immediately referred to the Standing Committee on Finance on 10.12.2010 by the Lok Sabha for examination and report thereon → In spite and despite that, the UID project started being implemented. So I am requesting all the file notings & instructions that led to the implementation of this project without the draft NIAI Bill 2010 being passed.



(b) Q.5 → All file notings of the urgency to commence the UID project under an executive order, rather than through Parliamentary process for a subject which has serious implications of biometrics privacy and security

Explanation for Q.5 → Notification No. A-43011/02/2009-Admn.I dated 28.01.2009 was circulated to a list of recipients to announce the constitution of an attached office under Planning Commission → Draft NIAI Bill 2010 was introduced in Rajya Sabha on 03.12.2010 → It was immediately referred to the Standing Committee on Finance on 10.12.2010 by the Lok Sabha for examination and report thereon → In spite and despite that, the UID project started being implemented. So I am requesting all the file notings & instructions that led to the project being implemented on an executive order, rather than wait for the Parliamentary process to ratify this project

Hence, let me have the replies to all the above or refer it back to CPIO in PM's office where it was sent in the first place as the PM heads the Planning Commission and so should have all the replies on file.
